

Information on Junior Firefighters Do's and Don'ts from RESA 3.

Here is what firefighters 16 and 17 can do and cannot do.

1. Do have a valid age certificate on file with the Chief
2. Do training conducted by the West Virginia Fire Service Training Program of WVU, RESA, or the WV State Fire Marshal's Office
3. Do First Aid
4. Do clean-up service at the scene of a fire, BUT outside the structure only, AND ONLY after the fire has been declared by the official in charge to be under control.
5. Do provide coffee and food service at the fire scene if needed, BUT ONLY outside of the structure and a safe distance from the structure.
6. Do enter a burn building during training sponsored and conducted by RESA
7. **DO NOT EVER** Operate pumps of any fire vehicle while at the scene of a fire
8. **DO NOT EVER** Drive any fire apparatus, ambulance, or other fire vehicle; and / or operate red lights, siren or an audible signal in responding to an alarm with their own personal vehicles or any other vehicle;
9. **DO NOT EVER** Operate an aerial ladder, aerial platform or hydraulic jack at a fire scene
10. **DO NOT EVER** Use or assist in the use of rubber electrical gloves
11. **DO NOT EVER** Use or assist in the use of insulated wire gloves
12. **DO NOT EVER** Use or assist in the use of insulated wire cutters
13. **DO NOT EVER** use or assist in the use of life nets
14. **DO NOT EVER** Use or assist in the use of acetylene cutting units
15. **DO NOT EVER** Use or assist in the use of K-12 power saws
16. **DO NOT EVER** Use or assist in the use of air chisels
17. **DO NOT EVER** Use or assist in the use of porta-powers
18. **DO NOT EVER** Use or assist in the use of hydraulic tools
